

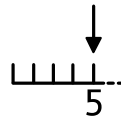
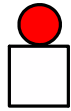
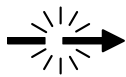


Bonfire Night

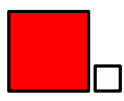
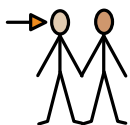
Bonfire Night is a special event.



It happens on November 5th every year.

















It is a time when some people celebrate.












They light a big bonfire and fireworks.

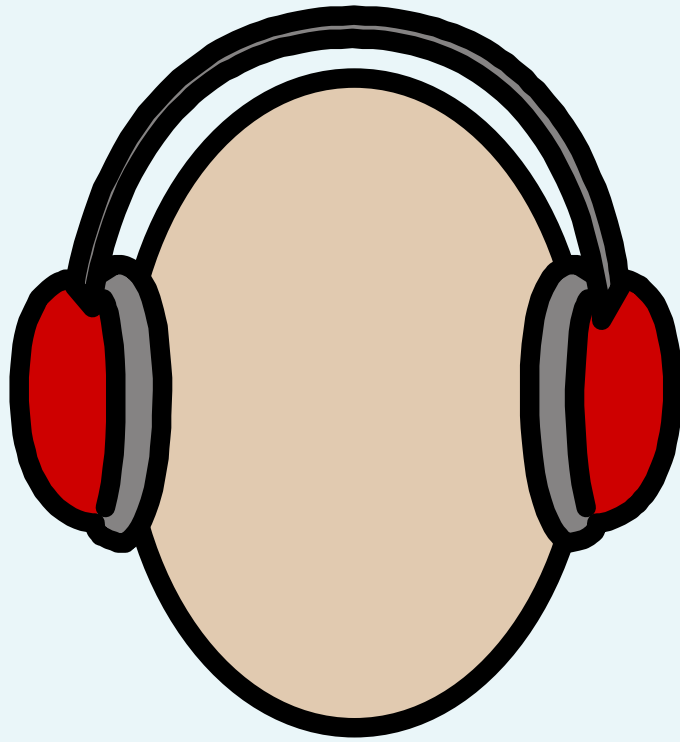


 On  Bonfire Night  some  people  like  to  set  off  fireworks.

If I find the fireworks noisy, I could wear my ear defenders.





If I find the fireworks noisy, I could cover my ears.

Always  listen to  adults about  safety around the  fire and  fireworks.









If I  feel scared,  worried,  frightened or a  different emotion,








I can  talk with **1**  of my  trusted adults.

They  will help me  do  something to  feel  safer.

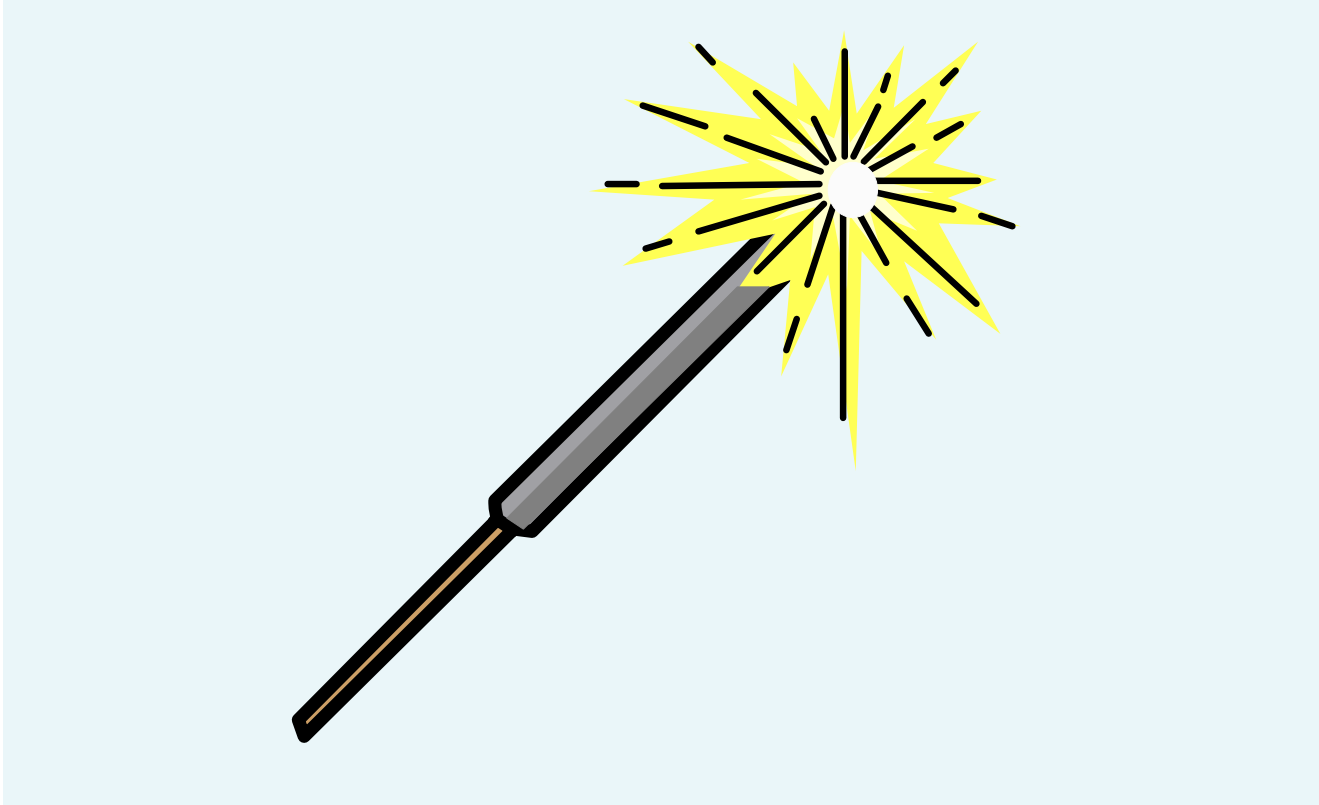


 Only  adults  will  light  the  fireworks.

 If  fireworks  are  on the ground,  I  will not  touch  them.






 It is  very  important  to stay  safe  on  bonfire Night.

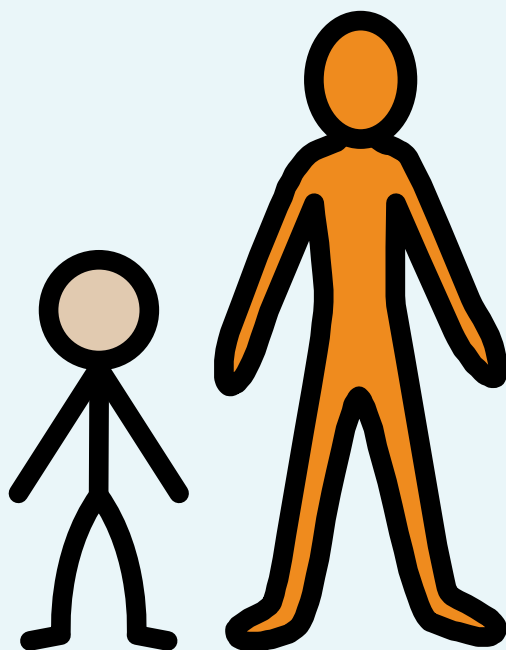


 I  may be allowed to  hold a  sparkler  and will  need to wear  gloves.
